- Protect informant's identity:** The warrant was based wholly or in part on information from a confidential informant. Evid. Code § 1041. However, the only information that may be sealed if information that would reveal, or tend to reveal, the informant's identity.

**DELAYED NOTIFICATION ORDER:** The affidavit herein has established sufficient reason to believe that immediate compliance with the notice requirements set forth in Penal Code § 1546.2(a) may have an adverse result as described in Penal Code § 1546(a) namely: *[Check one or more]*

- Endanger the life or physical safety of an individual.
- Result in flight from prosecution.

Accordingly, pursuant to Penal Code § 1546.2(b)(1), the court hereby orders DELAYING NOTIFICATION and PROHIBITING ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENT AND ANY PARTY FROM NOTIFYING ANY TARGET OR OTHER PARTY that any information has been sought and the content of the information until further order of court.

**DISPOSITION OF EVIDENCE ORDER:** Pursuant to Penal Code §§ 1528(a), 1536. all data seized pursuant to this search warrant shall be retained in Affiant's custody pending further court order.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS TO PROVIDER**

**Time of compliance:** Pursuant to California Penal Code § 1524.2(b)(1) you have five business days within which to respond to this warrant. If you believe that you have good cause as to why it must take longer than that to send the listed information to the Affiant, please contact him and ask for an extension. We will cooperate in any way we can.

**Verification:** If Provider is a foreign corporation as defined in California Corporations Code § 2105, it is required under California Penal Code § 1524.2(b)(4) to "verify the authenticity of records that it produces" by means of an affidavit that complies with the requirements set forth in California Evidence Code § 1561.

**COMPENSATION ORDER:** Affiant's agency shall reasonably compensate the Provider for such expenses incurred in complying with this order.
